Pistol - 10 Shot Pistol Shoot @ 25 yds immediately following match

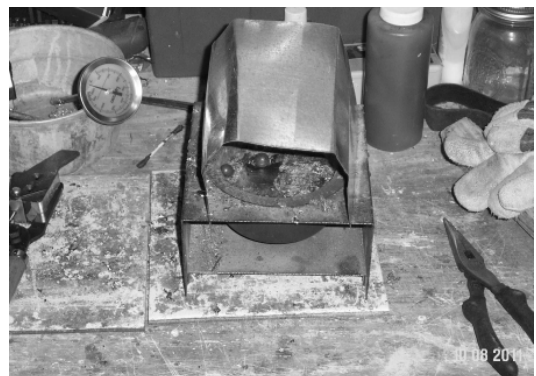
November 20th - Turkey Shoot
