

**Mulligan Match** For all you black powder shooters who have been heard to complain that they "wish they could have that shot over", here's your chance: The September monthly shoot will be a Mulligan match. Shooters can take *six shots* in every relay, instead of five, and *throw out their lowest scoring shot*.

**Sweeping up the Brass** The club is going to purchase push brooms and dust pans so we can all sweep up our empty brass cases after shooting. Loose brass can be a slipping and falling hazard. We don't want anyone to hurt themselves out there, (which has come close to happening several times during club matches. There have been several occasions where members have been observed to have more than the allowable number of guests at the range at one given time.
