# IMPORTANT: PISTOL RANGE RULE CHANGE

Rifles are no longer allowed to be shot on the pistol range, regardless of caliber or cartridge type. The pistol range is now just for shooting pistols of usual pistol calibers. If you want to shoot your .22 or 9MM AR, take it to the 25 yard line or longer ranges.












### **3<sup>RD</sup> SUNDAY SILHOUETTE SHOOTS ARE COMING BACK:**
