My Two Cents worth



What an exciting month June has been for our club. At the June meeting the Board of Directors voted to move forward with a large scale project to improve and enlarge the 100 yard range berm. As luck would have it the heavy equipment contractor was available to

begin on short notice so the range was closed 12 - 16 June while berm improvements were made. I understand that the short notice of the range closure may have inconvienced some members but that was a risk I was more than willing to take. This was a vital project to enhance the long term safety and viability of our range and club. The outcome nearly doubled the heighth of the berm. The Board also approved the purchase of additional railroad ties with the goal of replacing all of the steel target stands with the wooden ties. This will reduce ricochet risk as well as lower the point of aim along the entire firing line. Kudos to Gary Quandt and his property management team that have been busy this month working on gate and restroom repairs as well as a considerable amount of mowing from May's rains. Great job team.

Hopefully everyone has remained healthy durning the above average temperatures recently. Make sure to stay hydrated while at the range and be aware of the signs of heat injuries. Don't be a heat casualty.

This July 2, the First Sunday Match is a 20 shot silhouette match. This is a 25 & 50 yard event with squirrel and pig targets. So get those roundballs guns sighted in and come out and CLANG SOME STEEL and try to earn a pin!

The Texas Skirmish Association will host its annual "Beat the Heat" Skirmish on July 15. Uniforms are optional at this event due to the hot weather, however remember to wear closed toed shoes for safety.

Then the following day, July 16, will be a Third Sunday Fun Match 20 shot muzzleloader silhouette match. Same rules as the first Sunday match but only a \$5 shoot fee. Get out and enjoy some extra silhouette practice.

• We still have some bags of used .223 and .40 brass and a few other things left over from the reloading equipment sale, which will be sold at the first-Sunday shoots.


